



Day 1 - Wednesday

Cancun / Chichen / Merida

Transfer from your hotel in Cancun to the place of rendezvous where the tour begins, the road to Merida. Along the way you will discover the archaeological site of Chichen Itza, Yucatan Mayan capital that flourished on the peninsula between the 5th and 10th century AD. You can visit the imposing buildings of the central and northern parts of the city: the temple of Kukulcan, the ball game, the Observatory (Caracol), the Temple of the Warriors, the Convent of the Nuns and the Sacred Well (Cenote). Lunch at the restaurant. Continue to Merida in the afternoon, also known as the "white city" whose houses of the French colonial influences, Italian and Arabic of the early twentieth century testify to the former wealth whose origin was operation of sisal (agave Mexico). Accommodation at the Holiday Inn or similar.

Day 2 - Thursday Merida / Uxmal / Merida

Visit the archaeological site of Uxmal, whose name means "built in three stages". This is a fine example of classical architectural art and post-classic Maya. You will discover the main buildings as the Pyramid of the Magician, the Governor's Palace and the Nunnery. Lunch in a nearby restaurant. In the afternoon, return to Merida and enjoy a panoramic city tour. Overnight at hotel.

Day 3 - Friday Merida / Campeche

Visit to the Hacienda Sotuta del Peon, where you can enjoy the process of transforming fibre of sisal, a former Green Gold of Yucatan. Lunch. In the afternoon, continue to Campeche, the state capital of the same name. Visit the ancient fortified city protected by walls and several watchtowers, designed to defend the city against pirate attacks. Recently restored with refinement, the city intramural kept its colonial character with its beautiful old houses and religious buildings. Accommodation at Hotel Plaza Campeche or similar.

Day 4 - Saturday

Campeche / Palenque

Depart for Palenque. Arrival at the Hotel Ciudad Real or similar. Lunch and visit the afternoon, the archaeological site. You will be seduced by the beauty

of its buildings stone covered with stucco, an eminent example of the architectural style of the classical period. This mecca of Maya art whose structures are scattered in the heart of the Chiapas rainforest is considered one of the finest pre-Columbian cities of Mexico. The most amazing building is undoubtedly the Temple of the Inscriptions heart which were discovered the tomb of King Pakal and his famous jade mask. Overnight at hotel.

Day 5 - Sunday Palenque / Chicanna

Morning departure towards Chicanna, located in the stunning area "Rio Bec", the name given to the style of Maya architecture very special that can be enjoyed in this region where you can visit and little-known archaeological sites discovered recently. Stops during the trip to visit the archaeological area of Balamku where you can admire a huge relief in stucco with figures of royalty Maya and jaguars.

At the end of the visit, continuation to the hotel Chicanna Eco Village, the heart of the Mayan jungle and located opposite the archaeological area of Chicanna. Check-in at the hotel and lunch. In the afternoon, visit the site Chicanna whose name Maya means "House of the Mouth of the Snake". This site was discovered in 1967 and is characterized by its doors framed by masks shaped animals are especially appreciated the structure with its huge zoomorphic mask which is probably a Itzamná , the sun god . At the end of the tour , return to the Eco Resort and rest of the afternoon free to relax at the hotel listening to the chirping of crickets and other tropical birds which rest the body and mind. Overnight at hotel.

Day 6 - Monday Chicanna / Calakmul / Chicanna

A one hour drive from the hotel, we arrive at a deviation that enters the largest natural reserve in the country: Calakmul, the only true high Yucatan jungle still live with five of the six species of bobcat, more than 230 species of birds and a great botanical diversity. During the trip, we can enjoy a wide variety of the flora and fauna. After an hour and a half of small shaded road, we arrive at the archaeological site of Calakmul, considered an important Mayan city and located 25 km from the border with Guatemala. A Calakmul, over a hundred stelae disperse into the surrounding jungle, witness its influence in the region. From the top of its structures which is the largest in the area, and even some entire Maya monument area, we can contemplate the "green sea" of the vast Maya Biosphere. At the end of the visit, return to the hotel and lunch. Rest of the afternoon free . Overnight at hotel.

Day 7 - Tuesday Chicanna / Cancun

Departure in the morning for the Bacalar Lagoon also known as "Lagoon of the Seven Colors", for its waters that reflect several shades of turquoise, blue and green jade round along its 50 km. Lunch. Continuation to the Riviera Maya and Cancun.

End of services. The hotel in Cancun or Riviera Maya is not included in the price.
