Monday Arrive to San Salvador.

You will be met by our representative at the airport for transfer to your Hotel for accommodation. Overnight at San Salvador

Tuesday El Boquerón National Park -Joya de Ceren - San Salvador City tour

Breakfast. Let's start the day Visiting *El Boquerón National Park*, located on top of the San Salvador Volcano at 5,905 feet (1800 meters), its main attraction is a crater with 5 kilometers in diameter and 558 meters deep, The park features a visitors' center and short hiking trails up the side and along the rim of the crater, then continue to **Joya de Ceren Mayan Site**, This is a Mayan village that was covered by the ashes of a nearby volcano and discovered accidentally in the 70s, Time for Lunch (meals not included), following with a City Tour of San Salvador, including city center El Rosario church, government district, residential neighbourhoods, "the devils gate", relief map, downtown, Metropolitan Cathedral, The saviour of the world monument and more. Overnight at San Salvador **(B)**

Wednesday. San Salvador - Santa Ana – Copan.

Breakfast. Early on the morning, depart to Copan, on the way, take a short visit to Santa Ana City, El Salvador's third largest city, with a "must see" city center. Arrive to Copan and Time for Lunch (meals not included), during the afternoon, visit **Copán archaeological park** declared by UNESCO world heritage site. This park features a large Mayan city with some of the best architecture of that civilization. Next to the park is a museum that holds some of the artifacts that were found during excavations. Overnight at Copan **(B)**

PLEASE BE ADVISE TO CHECK VISA REQUIEREMENT BEFORE YOU LEAVE HOME, The

road to Copan is driving thru Guatemala for approx 2 hours. Some nationalities may require a visa .Fee for crossing the borders of Honduras. (~ \$ 5. per person)

Thursday. Copan – Rio Dulce- Flores.

Breakfast. Early on the Morning, depart to Rio Dulce River, where we will take a small boat to navigate on the river and I enjoy the views and the fresh air from the tropical forest. We arrive at Fuerte de San Felipe, built by the Spaniards to protect against the pirates attacks in the XVI century, later on transfer (4 hrs driving) to Petén Flores for accommodation. Overnight at Flores **(B)**

Friday. Flores Tikal – Guatemala City

Breakfast. We head to the magnificent Tikal Archaeological Park "the city of The Whisperers" ; you will admire the Twin Pyramids, The Palace, the Grand Plaza where the Gran Jaguar and Mascarones temples are. High above the IV temple you see the protected jungle. Lunch Box is included. Free time and at convenient time, transfer to the airport to fly back to Guatemala City. Arrival and transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Guatemala City. **(B-L)**

Saturday. Guatemala City – Antigua Guatemala.

Breakfast. Visit the capital of Guatemala, the largest in Central America with a population of over 2 million people. The visit includes the main plaza; Central Park and the Cathedral Lunch Time (Meals not Included) transfer to Antigua Guatemala and do a walking tour (3 hours) in Antigua Guatemala visiting the some of the important buildings of the colonial era. Overnight at Antigua Guatemala. **(B)**

Sunday Antigua

Breakfast. Day at leisure to explore Antigua. If Thursday or Sunday, We suggest you to take optional Tour to Chichicastenango and lake Atitlan. Overnight in Antigua. **(B)**

Monday. Breakfast. Transfer to airport. **(B)**
