

# LISBON . FÁTIMA . PORTO

## Day 1: Lisbon and Nazaré

Group arrival at LISBON airport, meeting and assistance by an Osiris representant and transfer to the hotel in NAZARÉ: the most typical and colorful fishing village in Portugal, known for its tasty gastronomy with special reference to the fish menus. Dinner and accommodation at Hotel.

## Day 2: Batalha, Fatima, Coimbra and Guimarães

Breakfast. In the morning departure to BATALHA, town was founded by King D. João I of Portugal, jointly with the Monastery of Santa Maria da Vitória na Batalha, UNESCO heritage (visit), to pay homage to the Portuguese victory at the Battle of Aljubarrota. Tour continues towards Fatima renowned as the "Worlds pilgrimage center" and afterwards COIMBRA the "city of Students" in Portugal famous for its university (1229), one of the oldest of Europe. At Coimbra time to visit of Santa-Clara church. The excursion heads to GUIMARÃES the cradle of Portugal. Dinner and accommodation at Hotel.

## Day 3 : Guimarães, Braga and Porto

After breakfast visit of GUIMARÃES. It is an historical city that had an important role in the formation of Portugal and it was settled in the 9th century. Guimarães is one of the country's most important historical cities. Its historical center is a UNESCO world heritage site. The city is often referred to as the "birthplace of the Portuguese nationality" or "the cradle city" Departure to BRAGA - this village is the oldest archdiocese and one of the major cities of the country, visit of the cathedral church. Departure to PORTO, the second largest village of Portugal, visit the old quarters on the riverside, the cathedral, guided visit of San Francisco church and in the end of the day visit and tasting in a famous cellar of Porto Wine. Dinner and accommodation at Hotel.







#### **Day 4: Aveiro, Alcobaca, Óbidos and Lisbon**

Breakfast. Departure to AVEIRO (the canals city). Departure to ALCOBAÇA (UNESCO) to visit the Church of the 12th Century Monastery, with the tombs of Dom Pedro and Dona Inês de Castro (“the dead queen”). Departure to ÓBIDOS. Obidos has been declared a national monument. One of Europe's most romantic medieval villages are its incredibly picturesque cobblestone streets lined with colorful houses-- all encircled by the walls of a 12th century castle. Return to LISBON. Dinner and accommodation at hotel.

#### **Day 5: Lisbon**

Breakfast. Departure for a sightseeing Tour of Lisbon: The old quarters of Alfama Moorish quarter, Downtown, Commerce square, Belem quarter with its monuments, Geronimo's Monastery (visit of the church), the Discoveries Monument (glimpse), the Belem Tower (glimpse). Dinner and accommodation at hotel.

### **Day 6: Sintra, Cabo da Roca, Estoril and Lisbon**

Breakfast. Full day visit dedicate to SINTRA region, a lovely place distinguished by its “Villa Palace”. (Entrance included). Lunch in a typical restaurant. Departure to CABO DA ROCA, the most western point of Europe. The tour will proceed along the colorful Bay CASCAIS, the cosmopolitan ESTORIL and finish in Lisbon. Dinner and accommodation at Hotel.

### **Day 7: Évora**

Breakfast. Free-day for personal activities and visits or possibility of an optional full day excursion to ÉVORA historic town considered UNESCO world heritage. Due to its well-preserved old town centre, still partially enclosed by medieval walls, and a large number of monuments dating from various historical periods, including a Roman Temple. Évora is also a member of the most ancient european towns network. Dinner and accommodation at Hotel.

### **Day 8: Departure**

Breakfast at hotel and check-out. Departure transfer out to Lisbon airport.
