



WINE AND GASTRONOMY





Day 1: LISBON

Upon arrival at LISBON airport meet and greet by OSIRIS local representative. You will be escorted to the bus for a Lisbon sightseeing tour and transfer to Hotel. Visit the Cathedral, Saint Anthony's Church, Panoramic visit of St. George's castle (6th Century), the Cathedral (6th century), and the monumental Belem Quarter where one will see St. Jerome's Monastery founded by King D. Manuel on the XV Century, declared a national monument in 1907 and, in 1983, the UNESCO has classified it as Cultural heritage. Stop by Belem Tower (1514) and the Monument of the Discoveries (1940). Dinner at Hotel or at a Typical Restaurant with Fado and Folk show (optional). Overnight at hotel.

Day 2: ÉVORA

Breakfast. Free-day for personal activities and visits or possibility of an optional full day excursion to ÉVORA historic town considered UNESCO world heritage. Due to its well-preserved old town centre, still partially enclosed by medieval walls, and a large number of monuments dating from various historical periods, including a Roman Temple. Évora is also a member of the most ancient European towns network. Dinner and accommodation at Hotel. Tour continues to a local wine producer (Alentejo is a very famous wine region). Guided visit, wine tasting. Return to LISBON. Overnight at hotel.

Day 3: Obidos and Bombarral

Breakfast at Hotel & Check-out. Departure to ÓBIDOS, a typical middle age museum village surrounded by walls. Tour continues to BOMBARRAL, to a local wine producer – Wine Cellar Sanguinhal. Guided visit, wine tasting and regional Buffet Lunch. Check-in, overnight at Pousada or similar Hotel. Free dinner.

Day 4: Porto & Vila Nova de Gaia

Breakfast at Hotel & Check-Out. Departure with destination to VILA NOVA DE GAIA, facing DOURO RIVER where famous Port Wine cellars are located. Visit of one of the local Wine cellars, wine tasting and Lunch. In the afternoon panoramic visit of Porto. Porto is the second largest city in Portugal. Its historical district has the well-deserved title of 'World heritage site' from Unesco and for two centuries now Porto has been internationally famous for the quality of its wine. A Tour in Porto will allow to discover magnificent monuments. Among these may be mentioned the Cathedral, the city "ex-libris" Clérigos, Sao Francisco Church besides the Stock Exchange Palace. Check-in at Hotel or Pousada. Free Dinner.

Day 5: Douro Valley

Breakfast. In 2001, UNESCO inscribed "Alto Douro Wine Region" in the World heritage list. Departure to PINHÃO, passing by AMARANTE, MESÃO FRIO and PESO DA RÉGUA. Visit to Quinta do Castelinho wine producer (according with availability) and wine tasting and regional lunch. The Douro valley is outstanding! Free Dinner. Check-in and Accommodation at Hotel.

Day 6: Douro Valley and Lisbon

Breakfast & check out hotel. Morning guided visit to a local farm in Douro region and light Lunch. Return trip with destination to LISBON. Farewell Dinner at typical Portuguese restaurant with Fado & Folk show. Accommodation at Hotel or Pousada in Lisbon.

Day 7: Departure

Breakfast at Hotel. Free Morning. Check-Out & Bus Transfer to LISBON Airport.
