Your journey continues around Lac Saint-Jean down to the Saguenay River where you will find Cap Jaseux Adventure Park. Zip along the forest canopy before retiring into your "Suspended Sphere". High in the trees, built away from other accommodation units on the site, the tranquility and privacy are assured to visitors while offering a breathtaking view of the Saguenay Fjord.

Day 4: Of sea and land Using a sea kayak, you will be amazed by the breathtaking and natural beauty of the majestic Saguenay Fjord. Simply paddling alongside the immense steep cliffs, or simply taking a well-deserved break, you may have the opportunity to see marine birds, seals, Beluga whales or even Minke whales. After the thrill of sea kayaking, it is time to sit back and let someone else do the driving; "All aboard" as the Train de Charlevoix awaits. Journey to wide open spaces, from curling wave crests to rocky mountain faces. Travelling along the St. Lawrence River between lush, verdant mountains and cresting waves, the train is a singular – yet irresistible – way of discovering the region. Meander through seven coastal towns and villages where putting down your bags feels wonderful, the time of a brief escapade with your sweetheart or family. Our day has come to an end at Le Germain Charlevoix Hotel & Spa, a charming country hotel with an undeniably urban feel. As you meander to the Lower Town (oldest area of Quebec City), you will view the Old Port Marina, alongside a quaint 'antique & art' district. Our walk leads us to the "Place Royale", birthplace of Quebec City. A few more steps and you arrive on Petit Champlain Street, one of the oldest commercial streets in North America. Return to the Hotel Port Royal for your last night in this unique city. End of Service.
